

LWA COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER College Bound Senior Timeline

SEPTEMBE	R:
	ASAP: September 16 th submit your check for the In School SAT Exam that will be held Wednesday October 14 th in the College and Career Center.
	Review your college plans and budget with your parents and decide what type of school is right for you.
	Create an account on OverGrad TOVERGRAD
	Research colleges that you are interested in. Set up virtual visits.
	Narrow your college list to 3 – 5 schools. Make sure to include a safe school, target school and reach school.
	Make a list of tests (SAT/AP), dates, fees, registration deadlines for college admissions. Start to STUDY! The College and Career Center has paper copies and spreadsheets to keep you organized.
	Meet with the College and Career Center to discuss: applications, due dates, college choices, etc to set up a plan.
	Start asking teachers, employers, for Letters of Recommendation
	Start working on your college essay with Sister Janet Gray
	Register for one of the SUNY Virtual College Fairs https://www.suny.edu/attend/events/virtual-college-fair/
OCTOBER:	
	October 1 st – START THE FAFSA for Financial Aid FAFSA and NYS TAP.
	October 14 th – Take the In School SAT. Make sure to have your scores sent to the colleges of your choice.
	Start filling out your College Applications
	Process your Request for Transcript with Sister Melissa in the LWA Office. NOTE – Requests will take at least two weeks to process.
	Finalize your College Essay with Sister Janet Gray
	Apply for scholarships.
	October 16 th – Registration Deadline for the May 2021 AP Fyams

NOVEMBER:		
	Apply Early Decision (binding)/Action (non-binding) for College Applications Continue to complete College Applications Apply for scholarships. Make sure to follow up on letters of recommendation.	
DECEMBE	R: Finish College Applications Apply for scholarships. Call the colleges you sent applications to, to make sure they have received all your information. Keep working hard in school – GRADES STILL MATTER!!	
JANUARY	Men over 18 must register for the Selective Service to receive Financial Aid. Talk to LWA graduates and friends about their college experiences to get as much information as you can. Begin receiving decisions from colleges. If you have not already done so complete the FAFSA / NYS TAP online. Study for AP Exams. Apply for scholarships.	
FEBRUAR'	Y: Finalize any late applications. Research colleges you have been accepted to and make your final decisions. Study for AP Exams. Apply for scholarships.	
MARCH:	Study for AP Exams.	

APRIL:	
	Receive Financial Aid packages from colleges where you have admitted.
	Review family finances.
	Make your final college decision.
	Study for AP Exams.
MAY:	
	May 1^{st} – Inform your college that you have accepted their offer to attend their college. Send in your deposit.
	Notify other colleges that you are declining their offer.
	First two weeks of May take the AP Exams.
	KEEP ON STUDYING – do not endanger your admission by doing poorly the end of the year.
	If you are attending a SUNY school make sure to complete the Excelsior Scholarship Application online.
